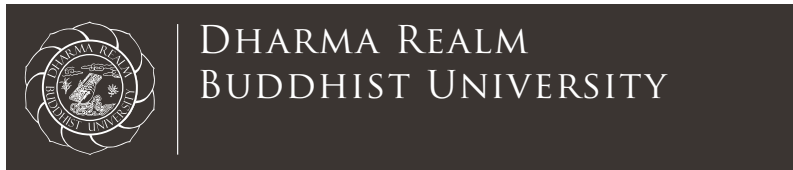

There is no minimum or maximum length requirement for the essays. Applicants generally write 500-1000 words per question. Please double-space, use 12 pt. font, and include your name on each page.

1. Why do you wish to attend DRBU Graduate Certificate Program in Buddhist Translation? What aspects of the program most appeal to you and why?
2. Please describe the languages you have learned, including the number of years and level of study, and your fluency (oral and written) in each.
3. Every college has rules governing campus life. Some regulations at DRBU are not commonly found at other colleges. For example, we maintain a vegetarian and alcohol-free campus. Students do not visit residence halls of the opposite gender and follow a dress code. Why do you think such regulations are relevant and important to the university experience? Please comment on your interest in living in this environment.
4. Describe a book or creative work (i.e. art, music, science) that has had an influence on you and explain that influence; or submit a graded paper you have already written on a work that has shaped your perspective and thoughts.
5. Please describe your long-term career goals and plans beyond your studies in this program.
6. Optional: If you wish, provide the Admissions Committee with any additional information that you think is relevant to our consideration of your application. You may describe previous translation work, if any, and/or attendance in related conferences, workshops, or programs. You may also wish to attach your resume and/or discuss your family situation, special talents or hobbies, religious life, and accomplishments.
